Rice export prices further dropped 1-2 percent despite the strengthening of the Thai baht.

Export prices of most grades of rice further dropped 1-2 percent from the previous week despite the strengthening of the Thai baht to \$1.00=36.54 baht from the previous week's exchange rate of \$1.00=36.68 baht. Domestic rice prices also decreased one percent from the previous week. Rice exporters expect downward pressure on domestic rice prices as rice mills are holding large inventories while export demand is slowing down and Thai white rice prices (5% grade) were \$37-\$62 higher than Vietnamese rice.

## **Rice Export Update**

Unofficial and preliminary rice exports (excluding Hom Mali fragrant rice) for June 10 - 16, 2024, totaled 181,524 metric tons, up 24,411 metric tons from the previous week and down 414 metric tons from the four-week moving average of 181,938 metric tons (Table 2). Rice exports from January 1 to June 16, 2024, totaled 4,030,277 metric tons, up 41 percent compared to the same period last year.

Note on data: Export figures since March 22, 2002, do not include fragrant rice. In addition, between May 1, 2013, and December 18, 2016, the Ministry of Commerce's Office of Commodity Standards took over reporting authority for rice exports and at that time the export data did not include 25% -100% grade white rice exports. Prior to May 1, 2013, and since December 18, 2016, the Thai Board of Trade has reported rice export data, which includes 25%-100% grade white rice. The reader should bear in mind these differences when comparing historical data with current data.
