Report Highlights:

Rice export prices of most grades of Thai rice further declined 1-2 percent despite the strengthening of the Thai baht.

Rice export prices of most grades of Thai rice further declined 1-2 percent from the previous week despite the strengthening of the Thai baht to \$1.00=36.04 baht from the previous week's exchange rate of \$1.00=36.29 baht. Domestic rice prices dropped 1-2 percent as supplies of new second-crop rice in the central plains area enter the market. In addition, new inquiries for white rice were quiet compared to the previous month even though Thai rice prices were competitive with Vietnamese rice prices. The export prices of Thai white rice, particularly for the 10-25 percent grade white rice, were \$38-45/MT lower than Vietnamese white rice.

Rice Export Update

Unofficial and preliminary rice exports (excluding Hom Mali fragrant rice) for July 1-7, 2024, totaled 139,902 metric tons, down 15,226 metric tons from the previous week and down 21,910 metric tons from the four-week moving average of 161,812 metric tons (Table 2). Rice exports from January 1 to July 7, 2024, totaled 4,496,001 metric tons, up 40 percent compared to the same period last year.

Note on data: Export figures since March 22, 2002, do not include fragrant rice. In addition, between May 1, 2013, and December 18, 2016, the Ministry of Commerce's Office of Commodity Standards took over reporting authority for rice exports and at that time the export data did not include 25% -100% grade white rice exports. Prior to May 1, 2013, and since December 18, 2016, the Thai Board of Trade has reported rice export data, which includes 25%-100% grade white rice. The reader should bear in mind these differences when comparing historical data with current data.
