### **Report Highlights:**

Rice export prices dropped 1-5 percent from the previous week due to the weakening of the Thai baht and India's removal of all export restrictions on non-Basmati white rice and on parboiled rice.

Thai export rice prices dropped 1-5 percent from the previous week as the Thai baht weakened to \$1.00=33.68 baht from the previous week's exchange rate of \$1.00=33.25 baht. In addition, export prices of white and parboiled rice declined 4-5 percent in response to the price competition from Indian rice after the Indian government removed all export restrictions for non-Basmati white rice and parboiled rice. Meanwhile, Thai exporters reportedly continued to secure the rice supplies to fulfill contract shipments.

### **Rice Export Update**

Unofficial and preliminary rice exports (excluding Hom Mali fragrant rice) for October 14 - 20, 2024, totaled 173,741 metric tons down 7,516 metric tons from the previous week and up 7,309 tons from the four-week moving average of 166,432 metric tons (Table 2). Rice exports from January 1 to October 20, 2024, totaled 6,771,102 metric tons, up 30 percent compared to the same period last year.

**Note on data:** Export figures since March 22, 2002, do not include fragrant rice. In addition, between May 1, 2013, and December 18, 2016, the Ministry of Commerce's Office of Commodity Standards took over reporting authority for rice exports and at that time the export data did not include 25% -100% grade white rice exports. Prior to May 1, 2013, and since December 18, 2016, the Thai Board of Trade has reported rice export data, which includes 25%-100% grade white rice. The reader should bear in mind these differences when comparing historical data with current data.
