Report Highlights:

Export prices rose one percent from the previous week. Thai rice exports during January to October 2024 were up 20 percent from the same period last year.

Export prices of most grades of Thai rice rose one percent from the previous week mainly due to a spike in demand for MY 2024/25 new-crop rice from ASEAN countries, ahead of the holidays. In addition, the Thai baht further strengthened to \$1.00=33.85 baht from the previous week's exchange rate of \$1.00=34.37 baht.

Department of Foreign Trade of the Ministry of Commerce reported that between January and October 2024, Thai rice exports totaled 8.35 million metric tons (MMT), up 20 percent from the same period last year. This total includes Hom Mali fragrant rice. The main markets for Thai rice during the first 10 months of 2024 were Indonesia (1.12 MMT), Iraq (0.95 MMT), South Africa (0.72 MMT), the United States (0.7 MMT), and the Philippines (0.49 MMT).

Rice Export Update

Unofficial and preliminary rice exports (excluding Hom Mali fragrant rice) for November 25 — December 1, 2024, totaled 134,088 metric tons down 23,073 metric tons from the previous week and down 13,195 metric tons from the four-week moving average of 147,283 metric tons (Table 2). Rice exports from January 1 to December 1, 2024, totaled 7,676,337 metric tons, up 22 percent compared to the same period last year.

Note on data: Export figures since March 22, 2002, do not include fragrant rice. In addition, between May 1, 2013, and December 18, 2016, the Ministry of Commerce's Office of Commodity Standards took over reporting authority for rice exports and at that time the export data did not include 25% -100% grade white rice exports. Prior to May 1, 2013, and since December 18, 2016, the Thai Board of Trade has reported rice export data, which includes 25%-100% grade white rice. The reader should bear in mind these differences when comparing historical data with current data.
