Export prices of Thai rice further dropped from the previous week as the Thai baht weakened to \$1.00=34.12 baht from the previous week’s exchange rate of \$1.00=33.96 baht. Also, exporters have secured white rice supplies to fulfill the contracted shipments to the Philippine and Indonesia. These shipments have taken placed since mid-December 2024 and will finish by January 2025.

Rice Export Update

Unofficial and preliminary rice exports (excluding Hom Mali fragrant rice) for December 9 – 15, 2024, totaled 167,873 metric tons up 33,854 metric tons from the previous week and up 19,588 metric tons from the four-week moving average of 148,285 metric tons (Table 2). Rice exports from January 1 to December 15, 2024, totaled 7,978,229 metric tons, up 20 percent compared to the same period last year.

Note on data: Export figures since March 22, 2002, do not include fragrant rice. In addition, between May 1, 2013, and December 18, 2016, the Ministry of Commerce's Office of Commodity Standards took over reporting authority for rice exports and at that time the export data did not include 25% -100% grade white rice exports. Prior to May 1, 2013, and since December 18, 2016, the Thai Board of Trade has reported rice export data, which includes 25%-100% grade white rice. The reader should bear in mind these differences when comparing historical data with current data.
