Effective December 3, the Vietnam Food Association raised the Minimum Export Prices from \$475 to \$540, per ton (FOB basis), for 5 percent broken rice, and from \$445 to \$480, per ton (FOB basis), for 25 percent broken rice for shipments in December 2010.

Local paddy prices went up last week due to limited on-farm paddy stocks.

Effective December 3, the Vietnam Food Association raised the Minimum Export Prices (MEP) from \$475 to \$540, per ton (FOB basis), for 5 percent broken rice, and from \$445 to \$480, per ton (FOB basis), for 25 percent broken rice for shipments in December 2010. According to exporters, this increase in MEPs is mainly due to the anticipation of sales to the Indonesian and Philippine markets, with shipments in early 2011. Most rice exporters matched the MEPs due to the limited quantity of exportable rice in the local market for these anticipated future sales. However, the warehouses of major exporters reportedly contain adequate stocks to fulfill outstanding contracts.

Local paddy prices went up last week, from VND 5,950-6,100 to VND 6,050-6,200, per kilogram. According to rice traders, this increase was due to limited on-farm paddy stocks.

The exchange rate was at \$1 to VND 19,500 as of December 3, 2010.
