**Report Highlights:**

U.S. dairy products exported to Kuwait must be accompanied by a U.S. Department of Agriculture sanitary certificate from the Agricultural Marketing Service. This report provides guidance for obtaining a certificate.

U.S. dairy products exported to Kuwait must be accompanied by a U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) sanitary certificate from the Agricultural Marketing Service (AMS). The [AMS website](#) provides sanitary information and instructions, plus a worksheet, to assist in obtaining a certificate. For Kuwait, certificate requests should include:

- The commonly used text identified in item 19 of the Sanitary Certificate Worksheet Instructions (“Description of Commodity [250]”); and
- A description of the animals providing milk that produced the dairy product, such as “cheddar cheese (Bos taurus)”.

Examples for common description of animals with scientific names in parentheses include:

- Cow (Bos taurus)
- Sheep (Ovis aries)
- Goat (Capra hircus)
- Water buffalo (Bubalus bubalis)
- Dromedary camel (Camelus dromedarius)
