Report Highlights: In 2000, Croatian sugar production declined to 60.000 tons because of drought. In 2001, domestic sugar-beet production will not be sufficient to meet domestic needs. Sugar production in the coming years will be heavily influenced by how quickly the three remaining sugar refineries in Croatia are privatized.
