# Turkey Grain and Feed TMO Tender Results 2007

# **Report Highlights:**

TMO finalized its tender and bought total of 55,000 MT of corn, 40,000 tons of which will come from the Ukraine and the remaining 15,000 tons will be sourced from Hungary, Serbia, Bulgaria, Romania, or Moldova. The delivery period will be June 18-30, 2007. Turkey paid between USD 232.20 per MT to USD 233.20 per MT for the corn.

Includes PSD Changes: No Includes Trade Matrix: No Unscheduled Report Ankara [TU1] Two weeks ago, the Turkish Grain Board (TMO) announced a tender for May 2, 2007 to buy corn. TMO finalized its tender results and announced that it bought a total of 55,000 MT of corn. The delivery period of the tender will be June 18-30, 2007. Turkey is not expected to import additional corn until 2008. The details of the tender are provided below:
