Tariff Hike on U.S. Agricultural Products put back to January 31

Report Highlights:

On December 17, 2018, the Government of India's (GOI) Ministry of Finance (MOF) deferred the enactment date of an increase in the Basic Custom Duty on several U.S. agricultural products (i.e. shelled and in-shell almonds, in-shell walnuts, fresh apples, and pulses) by 45 days, until January 31, 2019.

On December 17, 2018, the MOF issued notification <u>80/2018</u> announcing a 45-day delay, from December 17, 2018, to January 31, 2019, for implementation of increases in the effective Basic Custom Duty (BCD) on certain U.S. agricultural imports. If implemented, these tariff increases would apply only to U.S.-origin shelled and in-shell almonds, in-shell walnuts, apples, and pulses.

Background Information:

On June 20, 2018, the MOF issued notifications $\frac{48/2018}{48/2018}$ and $\frac{49/2018}{48/2018}$ announcing tariff increases on certain U.S.-origin agricultural products, effective August 4. (See GAIN <u>IN8078</u>)

On August 3, 2018, the Department of Revenue under the MOF issued notification $\frac{56/2018}{2018}$ that announced a 45-day delay, from August 4, 2018, to September 18, 2018, for tariff increases on certain U.S. agricultural imports to go into effect. (See GAIN <u>IN8093</u>)

On September 17, 2018, the MOF issued notification <u>62/2018</u> announcing a 45-day delay, from September 18, 2018, to November 2, 2018, for implementation of increases in the effective Basic Custom Duty (BCD) on certain U.S. agricultural imports by another 45 days, until November 2, 2018. (See GAIN <u>IN8108</u>)

On November 2, 2018, the MOF issued notification <u>77/2018</u> announcing a 45-day delay, from November 2, 2018, to December 17, 2018, for implementation of increases in the effective Basic Custom Duty (BCD) on certain U.S. agricultural imports. (See GAIN: <u>IN8124</u>)
