Turkey Cotton Update June 2010

Report Highlights:

MY 2010 Turkish cotton area and production in are now estimated to be 330,000 hectares and 500,000 MT. An increase in planting is reported in all regions due to high world prices and increased domestic demand. Domestic consumption for MY 2009 is now estimated about 1.2 MMT, about ten percent higher than earlier estimates. MY 2009 imports reached 681,000 MT in the first nine months of the marketing year and year end imports are expected to reach 820,000 MT. High U.S. cotton prices prevented a similar increase in Turkish imports from the United States, which remained at 312,000 MT (1.4 million bales) during the first nine months of the year. The GSM-102 Credit Guarantee Program continues to play an important role for U.S. exports to Turkey.

Production:

MY 2010 cotton area and production are now estimated to be about 330,000 hectares and 500,000 MT (2.3 million bails) due to larger than anticipated planting as a result of high world cotton prices. Planting increases are reported in all regions and favorable weather conditions are expected to increase yields.

Consumption:

MY 2009 domestic cotton consumption is now estimated to be about 1.2 MMT (3 million bails), which is about ten percent higher that early season estimates. The Turkish textile industry had higher than expected orders during the first half of the marketing year and some of the mills that were closed resumed operations. Accordingly, Turkish textiles and ready-to-wear item exports were up twenty-five and fifteen percent respectively during the first five months of 2010. However, recent economic problems in the EU member countries, where a majority of Turkish textiles are exported, have caused concerns among the Turkish textile exports. Decline in value of the Euro and the increasing value of the U.S. dollar are also sources of concern for Turkish textile manufacturers, as the Turkish textile industry buys its raw materials in U.S. dollars and sells finished products to EU member countries in Euros. In the mean time, an increase in domestic demand for textiles has brought some stability to the sector.

Turkish textile exporters benefit from geographical proximity to export markets, fast response time for orders and higher quality than their competitors. In recent years Turkish textile producers are increasingly focusing on design and technical textile products to increase sales.

Trade:

According to available information, Turkey imported about 681,181 MT (3.1 Million bails) of cotton during the first nine months of MY 2009, of which 312.214 MT (1.4 Million bails), or forty-six percent is U.S. cotton. This amount is lower than usual because of high U.S. cotton prices. Greece, the CIS countries, Brazil and India were the other suppliers. The GSM-102 credit guarantee program continues to play an important role in U.S. cotton sales to Turkey.

Turkish cotton exports during the same period were about 9,122 MT (41,870 bails), about 6,135 MT of which was to Turkish free trade zones, which means that some of this cotton may be imported back into the country. Turkey also exported about 16,650 MT of cotton for medical use during this period.
