
Ukraine is now able to issue electronic phytosanitary certificates through the International Plant Protection Convention's (IPPC) ePhyto Solution system. This will decrease transactional costs for Ukrainian exporters and increase transparency.

On February 3, 2025, the State Service of Ukraine for Food Safety and Consumer Protection (SSUFSCP) announced that it officially joined the <u>ePhyto system</u> and issued its first phytosanitary certificate in electronic form.

According to SSUFSCP's Head Serhiy Tkachuk: "From now on, Ukraine has the official status of a country that can exchange electronic phytosanitary certificates with 124 countries around the world, including the United States, Canada, EU countries, and Oceania using the international ePhyto system. And this is possible thanks to the great work of SSUFSCP team. This opens up new perspectives for Ukrainian producers, simplifies trade procedures, and makes the certification system more transparent and effective."

Paper certificates will remain for some shipments, as a number of destination markets are not yet members of the ePhyto system (see below).
