Report Highlights:

The Government of Vietnam (GVN) issued Decree 57/2020/ND-CP on May 25, 2020 revising Most Favored Nation (MFN) tariff rates on a number of agricultural products. The Decree will enter into force on July 10, 2020. MFN tariff rates are reduced for dairy products, ethanol, almonds, apples, grapes, wheat, walnuts, frozen potatoes, raisins, and chilled pork. A temporary reduction for frozen pork until December 31, 2020 has also been issued.

Summary

On May 25, 2020, the GVN issued Decree 57/2020/ND-CP, which will take effect on July 10, 2020, 45 days after signing. Decree 57 revises and supplements Decree 125/2017/ND-CP dated November 16, 2017, which revised and supplemented Decree 122/2016/ND-CP dated September 1, 2016, on schedules of export tariffs, preferential import tariffs, list of goods, flat tariffs, compound tariffs, and out-of-quota import tariffs.

The tariff reductions apply to selected products, including, milk and dairy products, fresh apples, grapes, dried grapes (raisins), frozen potatoes, almonds (in shell), walnuts (in shell), wheat (except Durum), chilled pork, and ethanol. Additionally, the MFN tariff rate for frozen pork (HS 0203.21.00; 0203.22.00; 0203.29.00) has been temporarily reduced from 15 percent to 10 percent, from July 10 until December 31, 2020.

According to the MFN principle of the World Trade Organization (WTO), these MFN tariff rates will apply to all Vietnam trading partners with whom Vietnam has no preferential arrangements in place (such as Free Trade Agreements or other bilateral or multilateral agreements with Vietnam). MFN tariff rates apply for the United States.
