#### **Market Tone**

Export prices for most grades of rice declined slightly as supplies of second-crop paddy came out gradually. However, foreign market demand was still quiet in light of the current cheaper priced Vietnamese rice. Trade sources expected that the market would be active again in May when Vietnam's rice supplies leveled out. As for the government intervention program for second-crop paddy, the authorities have announced the target of 2 million tons, starting March 20 until July 31, 2003. The program will pay \$117 /ton for 100% grade paddy, \$ 115 /ton for 5% grade, \$ 112 /ton for 10% grade, \$ 110 /ton for 15%, and \$ 106 /ton for 25% grade. Meanwhile, the government intervention program for the major crop (Nov 1, 2002 - Feb 28, 2003) has bought 3,345,505 tons of paddy (as of Feb 28, 2003) from 340,458 farmers, costing 17,690 million baht.

Note on data: Export figures since March 22, 2002 do not include fragrant rice. The authority to report fragrant rice exports was moved from the Thai Board of Trade to the Ministry of Commerce's Office of Commodity Standards, which does not release official fragrant rice export data. FAS/BKK will report only official export numbers from the Board of Trade for non-fragrant and from the Office of Commodity Standards for fragrant rice when available, but the reader should bear in mind the difference between the data.

Unofficial exports for Mar 3-9, 2003, totaled 47,288 tons, down 45,081 tons from the previous week's total and down 29,060 tons from the four week moving average of 76,348 tons. Exports during Jan 1- Mar 9, 2003, totaled 755 thousand tons, compared with 1,384 thousand tons (including fragrant rice) during the same period in 2002. Total rice exports (including fragrant rice) for Jan 1-Feb 28, 2003 were 1,113,172 tons, down 11.3 percent for the corresponding period in 2002.

According to Department of Internal Trade, Ministry of Commerce, total rice exports (including fragrant rice) during Jan1 - Mar 6, 2003 amounted to 1,150,389 tons, down 13.6 percent from 1,331,189 tons during the same period in 2002.
