Market Tone

Export prices for most grades of rice declined slightly as the government released more than 800 TMT of government held stocks to major exporters. Reports indicate that 300 TMT each was allocated to Chaiyaporn Rice CO., LTD. and President Agri Trading CO., LTD.; 200 TMT went to Capital Rice CO., LTD.; 30 TMT for Thai Fha CO., LTD.; and Pong Larp CO., LTD. received 10 TMT.

Official sources also indicated that government stock released for exports will likely reach 2 TMT by the end of CY 02.

Parboiled rice prices remain unchanged but strong, bolstered by continued demand from Nigeria.

Note on data: Export figures since March 22, 2002 do not include fragrant rice. The authority to report fragrant rice exports was moved from the Thai Board of Trade to the Ministry of Commerce's Office of Commodity Standards, which does not release official fragrant rice export data. FAS/BKK will report only official export numbers, but the reader should bear in mind the difference between the data.

Unofficial exports for Sep 1 - 7, 2002 totaled 102,917 tons, up 4,376 tons from the previous week and 8,784 tons from the four week moving average of 94,133 tons.

Exports during Jan1- Sep 8, 2002 amounted to 4,003,382 tons, compared with 4,571,172 tons (including fragrant rice) during the same period in 2001.

Fragrant rice exports totaled 490,417 tons during Jan - Jul 2002. Total rice exports (including fragrant rice) during Jan - Jul 2002 were 3,947,360 tons, up 6.9% from the corresponding period in 2001.
