**Report Highlights:** Total agricultural, fish and forestry imports into New Zealand from the world in 1999 increased by 7 percent from 1998 to reach U.S. \$1.3 billion. Imports of live animals increased 38 percent, cereals increased by 37 percent; beverages, spirits and vinegar increased by 15 percent, miscellaneous edible preparations rose 14 percent and imports of fishery products increased by 10 percent. Imports of raw hides and skins decreased by 22 percent as did coffee, tea and spice imports.
