**Report Highlights:** This report provides a broad overview of export certificate requirements for a representative sample of products exported to New Zealand. All sections of this report have been reviewed and updated to reflect New Zealand's most recent requirements. However, as these regulations are constantly updated, exporters interested in exporting to New Zealand are encouraged to check relevant websites for the most up-to-date information.

# Section I. List of All Export Certificates Required By Government (Matrix):

### **Summary**

Biosecurity New Zealand (BNZ) and the New Zealand Food Safety Authority (NZFSA) are the two key governmental organizations that regulate food imported into New Zealand.

Biosecurity New Zealand, an agency within the Ministry of Agriculture and Forestry (MAF), has the lead role in biosecurity protection (e.g. preventing unwanted pests and diseases being imported into New Zealand, and for controlling, managing or eradicating them should they arrive). Biosecurity New Zealand merged with MAF Quarantine Services in 2007 and both organizations now fall under the umbrella of MAF Biosecurity New Zealand. MAF Biosecurity New Zealand employs approximately 1,060 people, of which, 900 work in biosecurity. Of these 900 employees, approximately 550 employees are involved in border security/protection.

New Zealand has strict biosecurity rules and most unprocessed products cannot be imported into New Zealand unless an import health standard has been developed. New Zealand defines biosecurity as "the exclusion, eradication or effective management of risks posted by pests and diseases to the economy, environment and human health." New Zealand's biosecurity requirements cover terrestrial, freshwater and marine environments. Import health standards specify the biosecurity requirements that must be met for trade to occur.

In New Zealand, import health standards are based upon risk analyses, which assess either a commodity or a pest/pathway combination. Biosecurity New Zealand takes legislative requirements and international obligations into account when conducting risk analyses and developing import health standards. The principal document for all New Zealand import health standards is the Biosecurity Act (1993). The act provides for management of risks associated with imported goods such as produce, seeds and plants principally through import health standards. New Zealand also adheres to the guidelines on risk analysis developed under the auspices of the Interim Commission on Phytosanitary Measures operating within the framework of the International Plant Protection Convention, and the World Trade Organization Agreement on the Application of Sanitary and Phytosanitary Measures. The New Zealand Food Safety Authority (NZFSA) sets policies, criteria and procedures to monitor the safety of imported food for human consumption. Established in July 2002, NZFSA was a semi-autonomous body attached to Ministry of Agriculture (MAF) until it became a stand alone department in July 2007. NZFSA maintains generic clearance procedures for all foods imported into New Zealand. If an imported product is of regulatory interest to NZFSA, it will likely require exporters to comply with additional specific import procedures and associated requirements. These requirements are set down in the Imported Food Requirements

(IFRs). Examples of products that fall under these requirements include peanuts, pistachios, shell fish etc., as they have been found to contain mycotoxins, mold and insects.
