Oilseeds and Products Update

Update (May)

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Report Highlights:

Malaysia's crude palm oil (CPO) production dropped 5.8 percent to 1.3 MMT in April 2009. Post revised CPO output slightly upwards to 18.5 MMT for 2009/10. PO exports declined 8.2 percent to 1.3 MMT in April. Lower CPO output resulted in a lower stock level at the end of April. In line with a softer global oilseed market, the monthly average delivered CPO price declined to RM2,535/MT in May.

Executive Summary:

Production

The Malaysian Palm Oil Board (MPOB) reported that total crude palm oil (CPO) production dropped 5.8 percent to 1.3 MMT in April 2010. Peninsular Malaysia's production dropped 7.4 percent while East Malaysia's output was also down by 3.8 percent. Compared to April 2009, output during April 2010 was 26 percent higher. Despite a dip in April, the industry is expecting a seasonal uptrend in output till October. Post expects CPO output to be about 4.4 TMT during the Apr-Jun quarter.

Price

The monthly average delivered CPO price declined to RM2,426/MT by mid-May before moving upwards in the latter half of the month to reach RM2,535/MT by the end of May. For comparison, the average CPO price for May 2009 was RM2,744/MT. Currently, the key determinant of the CPO price movement is the euro-dollar exchange rate. Refined/Bleached/Deodorized (RBD) Palm Oil FOB average price rose from US\$804/MT in April to US\$808/MT in May.

Stocks

Lower CPO output resulted in a lower stock level at the end of April. Compared to May 2009, the stock level is higher by 330 TMT. Post expects exports to increase as the Islamic countries to stock up for the month of Ramadan (August). The stock level is expected to decline to 1.3 - 1.4 MMT by end of June before increasing to 1.6 MMT by the end of September.

Trade

A preliminary official report shows PO exports declined by 8.2 percent to 1.3 MMT in April. Cargo surveyor Societie Generale reported Malaysian palm oil exports rose 6 percent during May 1-25 compared to the corresponding period in April.

Annual Situation

Changes in the PS&D table reflect a slight upward revision in CPO production for 2009/10 as El Nino effects were not as serious as expected. Imports of Indonesian CPO were revised upwards to help fill the increase in overseas demand. Domestic use was reduced with ending stock remaining at 1.6 MMT.
