#### Situation for the Week Ending December 30, 2011

**Report Highlights:**

Given the Vietnam Food Association's Minimum Export Prices (MEP), rice exporters last week offered export rice prices at the same level as the required MEP levels. The 5 percent broken rice price was quoted at \$500 per ton and the 25 percent broken rice was quoted about \$450 per ton.

Local paddy rice prices went further down due to peak harvest of the late Autumn crop in the Mekong River Delta and almost no export demand.
