Rice Imports Fourth Quarter 2009

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Report Highlights:

Senegal rice imports in the fourth quarter of 2009 decreased slightly (2%) compared to the previous quarter (184,824 MT vs. 187,355 MT). Broken rice remains the most preferred rice imported in Senegal with more than 99% of the market share. Thailand remains the largest rice supplier in the country with 57% of the market share followed by Vietnam (28%) and Brazil (11%). USA is the 7th export country in Senegal with 38 MT of paddy rice imported this quarter.

Executive Summary:

Senegal's rice imports in the fourth quarter 2009 reached 184,824 MT representing a decrease 2% compared to the previous quarter (see Table 1).

More than 99% of the rice imported is broken rice mostly supplied by Thailand (See table 3). Among the export countries, Thailand remains the largest supplier with 57% of the market share followed by Vietnam (28%) and Brazil (11%) (see Table 2).

This fourth quarter, Senegal imported 38 MT of US rice which represents less than 1% of the total market share and a decrease of 39% compared to the previous quarter. Only paddy rice was imported from the US (see Table 1 and 2).

Senegal imported has a preference in semi or whole milled rice packaged in bags weighting more than 5 Kilogram. (see Table 3)
